

COVID TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

as of 3/11/22

The Safe Travels program requirements to enter the state of Hawaii will end on March 25 and will no longer be required starting March 26 (group departure day).

However, because you will be traveling to Hawaii <u>prior</u> to March 26, you will still need adhere to the requirements. Please follow the instructions below.

Safe Travels Hawai'i Registration

Completing the State of Hawaii's Safe Travels Hawaii program application form, uploading COVID-19 test result or vaccination record document (if applicable) and obtaining your QR code *PRIOR TO* departure will significantly reduce your airport screening and processing time at arrival.

Prior to your departure for Hawai'i, if you are an adult (age 18 years or older) you will need to create an online user account and register with the State of Hawai'i <u>Safe</u> <u>Travels Hawai'i</u> program. This applies only for domestic passengers from the U.S. and its Territories. Visit:

Once you create your **Safe Travels Hawai'i account**, you will next need to enter your traveler information and trip details on the program's application form. It is important to get the correct test and upload the correct form or vaccination record document.
